Background

animal – science proceedings (formerly *Advances in Animal Biosciences*) is part of the *animal* family of journals. The animal family is managed by a consortium of BSAS, EAAP and INRAE. The journal will publish high-quality conference, symposium and workshop proceedings on aspects of the life sciences with emphasis on farmed, other managed animals, leisure and companion animals, aquaculture and the use of insects for animal feed and human food. These can be in the form of short abstracts, one to two-page summaries or short papers. The conferences can be international or regional/ national.

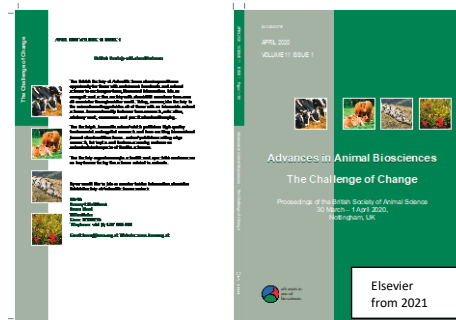
Why publish your conference in *animal – science proceedings*
